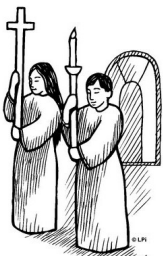
Our next celebration of the Sacrament of Baptism will be held Sunday, August 8<sup>th</sup>.

## **Music Notes**

*from Roger*

It would seem that the 'Cat is out of the Bag'. This church sings. Both I and my Cantors have been noticing over the last several months that the singing is getting stronger at all Masses. The Hymns, (*especially when they're some of the ol' Chestnuts*) the Responsorial Psalm, and the Mass Parts all seem to have a greater feeling of gusto and participation. There are times when I marvel at how strong and full the singing is during some of the Masses. It certainly lifts me up and I trust that it becomes an infectious opportunity for all to experience worship at a higher level with a deeper and more personal awareness of one's relationship to our Lord.

There are so many opportunities for us all to become more deeply involved in our worship life. Music is an integral part of any Mass or worship service; it is a vital way of connecting us with our heritage. When we sing hymns, responses, psalms, and anthems with music and texts that have lived for generations, there is a oneness in the worshipping body that connects us with Christians around the world and throughout the centuries of Christianity. I believe that we are fed and nurtured not only through the Eucharist and the spoken word, but also through music and songs that have been inspired by God and all of Creation. Whether the piece is a chant setting from our early Christian heritage, a Bach choral, a lush romantic anthem, or a favorite hymn, music in worship brings people closer together, causing a stirring deep within that is as mysterious as faith itself.

Having said all of this, I will be away from my bench at the organ for the next two weeks for some time off with my family. There will be music at some of the Masses, but overall, a rather quieter period. As we reach the height of summer and look towards the fall, I hope that you'll take this time to reflect on how you might like to take part in the Music Ministry at IC. My hope is that we will continue to grow in our worship life and that music will continue to be a vehicle for people to use to express their innermost thoughts and prayers as we come together at Mass to worship and receive Christ.
