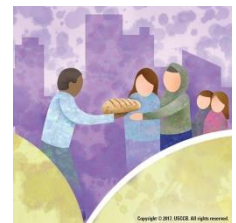

The K-8 Pflaum Gospel Weeklies Class is offered during the academic year on two days:

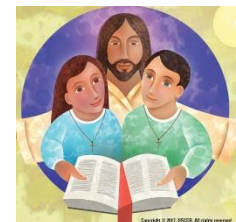
Sunday – 10-10:50 AM:
